Operations at Manza Onsen Ski Resort and Manza Kogen Hotel This Winter

Manza Onsen Ski Resort will be reducing the number of ski lifts and available ski courses in operation during the 2025 to 2026 season. As a consequence of this, the operations of Manza Kogen Hotel will be temporarily consolidated into Manza Prince Hotel.

We apologize deeply for this inconvenience to our customers and everyone else affected.

The details of operations are as follows.

1. Manza Onsen Ski Resort Operating Season

December 20 (Sat), 2025 to March 22 (Sun), 2026

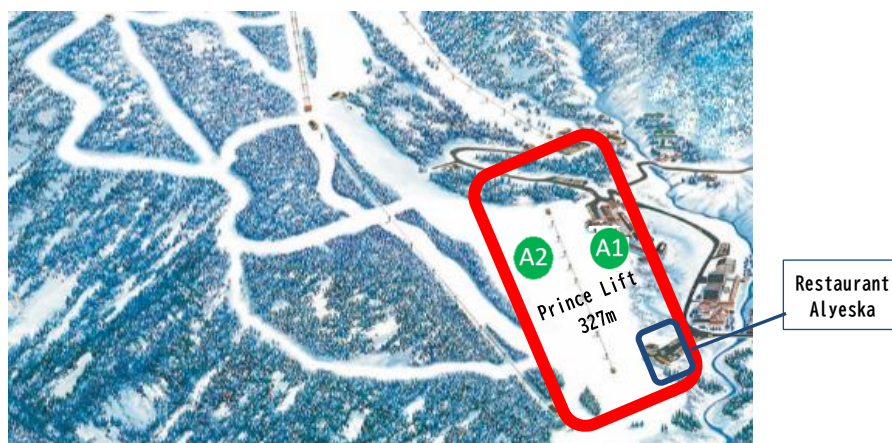
*The dates may vary based on the amount of snowfall.

2. Manza Onsen Ski Resort Operations Details

- Only the Prince Lift will be in service

- *The Panorama Lift A and B lines, Manza High-Speed Lift, and Mt. Manza Lift will be closed

- There will be 2 ski courses available: the A1 course and A2 course on either side of the Prince Lift. Additionally, Restaurant Alyeska will be open as a rest area. We will provide information on lift fees at a later time.



3. Reason for Reduced Operations

In September 2024, electrical cables and circuit breakers, etc., were stolen from the ski lifts and restaurants on the slopes at the ski resort. It will require time for the delivery and installation of the electrical equipment needed for repairs, so we are reducing ski resort operations for this season.

4. Manza Kogen Hotel Operations Consolidation

Based on demand for accommodations due to the above circumstances, we will be consolidating the operations of Manza Kogen Hotel into Manza Prince Hotel during the following period.

[Operations Consolidation Period] January 4 (Sun) to March 21 (Sat), 2026

- *In addition, we will be closed for maintenance from March 22 (Sun) to April 3 (Fri), 2026.

- *We will also be suspending operations of the day-trip hot spring during the operations consolidation period, but the details of operations may be subject to change. If this occurs, we will make an announcement on our website, etc.
