NIJYUROKUYA in TAKANAWA

Takanawa area was a famous place for viewing the moon and the sea. During the EDO period (1603-1868), on the 26th day of January and July, people gathered to wait for the moon and to pray. This event has been revived in the Takanawa area as Takanawa Nijurokuya.

Over 400 bamboo lanterns illuminate the Japanese garden every evening to promote relaxation and connection to nature.
