Suite rooms and Club Lounge reopened on Wednesday, October 1st, and the bar and restaurants on Friday, October 3rd.

The Prince Park Tower Tokyo (Address: 4-8-1 Shibakoen, Minato Ward, Tokyo, General Manager: Yasutoshi Kanda) has been undertaking a series of renovations since late May 2025, and with all renovations completed, the 32F suite rooms and Premium Club Lounge reopened on Wednesday, October 1, 2025, followed by the 33F Sky Bar & Dining Stellar Garden and Private Dining Brise Verte on Friday, October 3, 2025.

The Prince Park Tower Tokyo opened in 2005 as Tokyo Prince Hotel Park Tower, and we are celebrating our 20th anniversary as the flagship hotel of Prince Hotels this year. Favorably situated near Shiba Park, with its lush greenery in the heart of the city, the location is rich in history and culture, and we are favored by many patrons as a luxury hotel where guests can enjoy a view of Tokyo Tower soaring right before one's eyes.

As for the renovations we conducted for our 20th anniversary, in addition to sightseeing, dining, and shopping, in recent years, there has been an emphasis on capturing photos and video as a reason for travel among foreign visitors to Japan. Through these renovations, we provide a unique, unrivaled location offering spectacular views from every area as a hotel situated in a spot with fantastic scenery where guests can capture beautiful shots of Tokyo's iconic Tokyo Tower and the Tokyo nightscape.

# **Design Overview**

Based on the concept of 'Tokyo Fusion,' we have created spaces that convey refined, modern luxury — loved by our diverse guests — ensconced within Tokyo's cityscape near Tokyo Tower and surrounded by history and culture. For accent colors, we incorporated international orange to complement Tokyo Tower and the green of Shiba Park stretching below, and everywhere there is interior decor reinterpreting the glittering upper floors and traditional culture in a modern style.

## **Renovations Overview**

#### 1. Sky Bar & Dining Stellar Garden

- Fully renovated to allow enjoying Tokyo Tower and fantastic Tokyo scenery from any seat, and expanded seating to 84 seats.
- The Platinum Seats directly facing Tokyo Tower are limited to three groups per day.
- Created a new dining area with fantastic views of Mt. Fuji and Tokyo.
